

"At the recent Knights of Columbus State of New Hampshire convention in Nashua, KofC Claremont Fr. Cote Council 1820 was recognized with an Award for its Community Service project assisting a St. Mary's parishioner with needed roof repairs and a new shingled roof! The award features the KofC Third Degree insignia and a picture of Fr. Michael J. McGivney, founder of the Knights of Columbus on March 29, 1882. The Order was founded on the principles of Charity, Unity and Fraternity and fosters aid and action in six program areas: Church, Community, Council, Family, Youth, and Culture of Life.

The Council 1820 project earning the recognition of the State Council in this award, was the installation of a new roof on part of the home of St. Mary's choir musician and music arranger Ursula Ramjit in Claremont. Council Knights, contributed time, labor and funds for the labor and materials necessary to repair the aged and leaking roof section of her home. The Knights also secured a 50% community charity program discount from the local Home Depot which furnished the shingles and other roof materials! The job was started and completed in two days time on the weekend of August 20th and 21st, 2016."
