The Adoration Chapel is Re-Opening! Tuesday, August 15th

Mass on the Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary (Holy Day of Obligation) will be celebrated in St. Mary Church at 5:00 PM. Following Mass Fr. Sebastian will lead a procession of the Blessed Sacrament to the Chapel and Our Lord will once again reside in the Chapel! Father will bless the Chapel and conduct an hour of Adoration.



We have a new tabernacle for the Chapel, an Exposition Tabernacle! This will allow for Eucharistic Adoration without the need of a commissioned Extraordinary Minister of the Eucharist to expose and repose the Blessed Sacrament. The new tabernacle has a door that one would open to adore and then close when leaving. The Blessed Sacrament is secure behind a glass partition and the tabernacle will remain locked at all times. The Exposition Tabernacle prevents any abuse in exposition or reposition and will allow easier access for everyone to spend time with Our Lord in Eucharistic Adoration. What a blessing!



The tabernacle is a beautiful but expensive purchase for the Parish and Fr. Sebastian is asking for donations to help offset the cost. Donations may be made in memory of a loved one and will be commemorated in the Chapel.

The Parish has contracted with Tasco Security Systems to install recording security cameras on the exterior of the building, as well as other locations on the parish campus. There will be 24/7 monitoring of the property. New lighting will also be installed on the exterior of the Annex building. These measures are being taken to help parishioners feel safe to visit the Lord at any time.

The interior Chapel door will be outfitted with a punch-code lock as well. Those making a visit will have access to the Chapel and bathroom only. Parishioner Charlene Addario has generously volunteered to maintain the Chapel and keep it clean. Thank you, Charlene!

Friday, August 4th, was the last scheduled First Friday Adoration in the main church. The Thursday evening hour of Adoration will be conducted in the Chapel beginning August 17th.

Anyone wishing to have the code for both doors will be asked to come into the Parish Office to receive the code and instructions.
