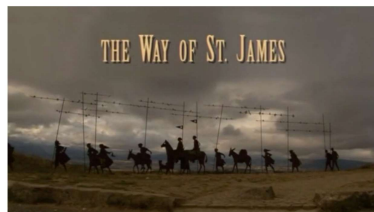

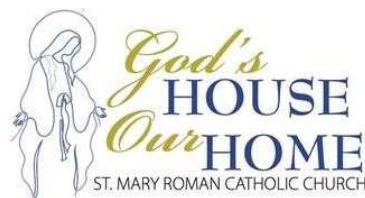
The Way of Saint James
