
NOW AVAILABLE IN ST. MARY CHURCH:

At the beginning of the new liturgical year, which begins with the First Sunday of Advent, we will be officially switching to a new hardcover book to be used at Mass. It is the CREDO Hymnal with Lectionary and contains readings for all 3 years in the liturgical cycle as well as over 650 hymns and songs. The CREDO Hymnal is the most complete traditional hymnal in the Church today.
