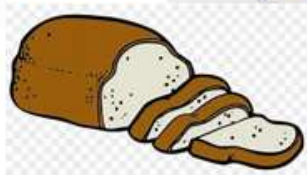

Sr. Helena wrote and directed a documentary on the life of the Church's new media saint, Blessed Father James Alberione (MediaApostle.com) and is a co-producer on The40Film.com. She has written a Theology of the Body curriculum used in her online TOB Certificate Course through Sacred Heart College, Peterborough, ON, Canada. Sr. Helena gives Media Literacy & Theology of the Body workshops and courses to youth & adults all over Canada and the U.S. and believes that media can be a primary tool for sharing God's love and salvation.
