Each month the prayer requests to St. Jude will be moved to an envelope and placed on the altar to be offered during the Mass. They will then be privately burned afterwards.


The healing Mass may be offered each month for up to 3 different intentions, so if you would like to schedule an intention for the Mass please call the Parish Office.


